Insurance Exemption Form Early Intervention Colorado

The service coordinator plays a key role ensuring parents and legal guardians understand that the use of benefits for children who are enrolled in private or public health insurance plans for any and/or all early intervention services that are identified in a child's Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) must be considered prior to the use of any other public funding sources. The use of private or public insurance will not be required in the following Early Intervention or health insurance system related circumstances:

- There are no local service providers who contract with the child's/family's insurance carrier for the service(s) specified on the IFSP or who will provide the service(s) in accordance with the IFSP (e.g., in a natural environment or in the native language of the family).
- Use of insurance would increase premiums or cause discontinuation of insurance.
- Cost of the co-pay or deductible for private health insurance is more costly than using other sources of public funding.
- Insurance carrier has denied payment for the early intervention service on the IFSP. Please attach copy of denial letter.
- Other (specify details of situation)

I assure the family's/child's insurance benefits cannot be utilized for payment for some or all early intervention services specified on this child's IFSP for the reason(s) indicated above.
