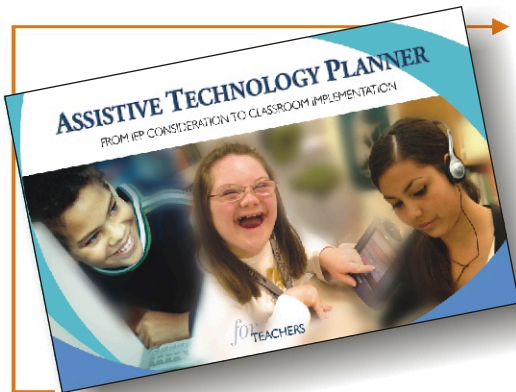

Technology and Media for Accessing the Curriculum— Instructional Support for Students with Disabilities

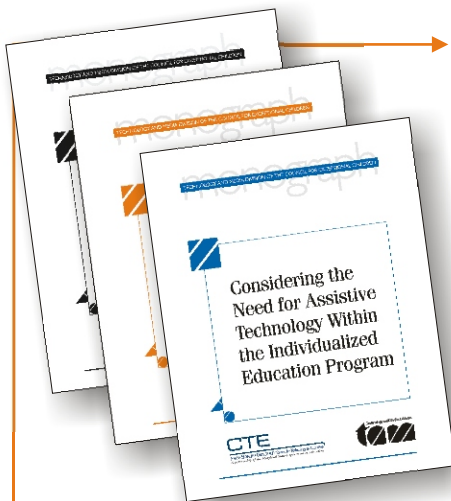
